RUSSIAN (RUSS)

RUSS 101 Elementary Russian I 3 Credit Hour(s)

This is an introductory course designed to place emphasis on functional grammar, practical vocabulary, listening skills, and conversation in Russian. This course will serve as a basis for further development of proficiency in reading, writing, understanding, and speaking the Russian language

RUSS 102 Elementary Russian II 3 Credit Hour(s)

Prerequisite: RUSS 101

This course will further the objectives of RUSS 101 while expanding the student's knowledge of practical vocabulary and functional grammar. This course will serve as a basis for further development of proficiency in reading, writing, understanding, and speaking the Russian language.

RUSS 201 Intermediate Russian I 3 Credit Hour(s)

Prerequisite: RUSS 102

This is the first half of an intermediate course that places continued emphasis on functional grammar, practical vocabulary, listening exercises, and conversation in Russian. This course expands the basic proficiencies in speaking, listening, reading, and writing the language acquired in RUSS 101 and 102. This course is conducted primarily in Russian.

RUSS 202 Intermediate Russian II 3 Credit Hour(s)

Prerequisite: RUSS 201

Continued emphasis on functional grammar, practical vocabulary, listening exercises and conversation in Russian. This course expands the basic proficiencies in speaking, listening, reading and writing the language acquired in Russian 101, 102 and 201. This course is conducted primarily in Russian.
