## **WRIT 201 Introduction to Creative Writing 3 Credit Hour(s)**

Students will learn the literary components, complexity, and craft of creative writing.

**Offered:** Resident and Online

## **WRIT 303 Writing Poetry 3 Credit Hour(s)**

A study of developing poetry writing skills using various techniques and poetic forms.

**Offered:** Online

## **WRIT 304 Novellas 3 Credit Hour(s)**

A creative writing course focused on writing novellas.

**Offered:** Resident and Online

## **WRIT 305 Introduction to Inspirational Writing 3 Credit Hour(s)**

A study of the history and practice of inspirational writing.

**Offered:** Resident and Online

## **WRIT 306 Writing for Theater and Film 3 Credit Hour(s)**

Exploration of the fundamental craft of writing for theater and film, focusing on the creation of dramatic narrative story and the formation of multi-dimensional characters.

**Offered:** Online

## **WRIT 307 Memoirs 3 Credit Hour(s)**

An exploration of the conventions for writing memoir, biography, autobiography, and other related genres.

**Offered:** Online

## **WRIT 400 Editing for Publishing 3 Credit Hour(s)**

This course provides students with a practical working knowledge of the fundamentals of editing for publishing.

**Offered:** Resident and Online

## **WRIT 401 Grant-Writing 3 Credit Hour(s)**

This course presents the principles and strategies of preparing funding proposals.

## **WRIT 402 Methods and Materials of Research 3 Credit Hour(s)**

**Prerequisite:** ENGL 101

An introduction to the research and bibliographic methods necessary for successful creative writing.

**Offered:** Resident and Online

## **WRIT 403 Technical Writing 3 Credit Hour(s)**

This introductory course helps students develop skill sets for writing for diverse audiences in various technical fields.

**Offered:** Online

## **WRIT 404 Print and Digital Publishing 3 Credit Hour(s)**

An introduction to professional publication, focusing on the building of platforms and publication record resulting in the maturation of the writer's skills and brand.

## **WRIT 405 Fashion Writing 3 Credit Hour(s)**

This course explores the history, theory, and practice of fashion writing as a means for reporting, analysis, business, and cultural commentary.

## **WRIT 417 Writing for Cultural Engagement 3 Credit Hour(s)**

Exploration of writing focusing on rhetorical strategies, cultural contextualization from a biblical perspective, and theological nuance necessary for Christian writers.

## **WRIT 490 Creative Writing Workshop 3 Credit Hour(s)**

**Prerequisite:** WRIT 201

This course is designed for the production and revision of a chosen creative piece.

## **WRIT 491 Senior Capstone 3 Credit Hour(s)**

**Prerequisite:** WRIT 201

This course is a senior level capstone seminar that results in a project that integrates material from the student's degree that must be synthesized into a writing project.

## **WRIT 497 Special Topics in Writing 3 Credit Hour(s)**

**Prerequisite:** ENGL 101

This course focuses on a particular form, topic, or genre of writing.

Internship of 180 hours in a field/role related to writing.
